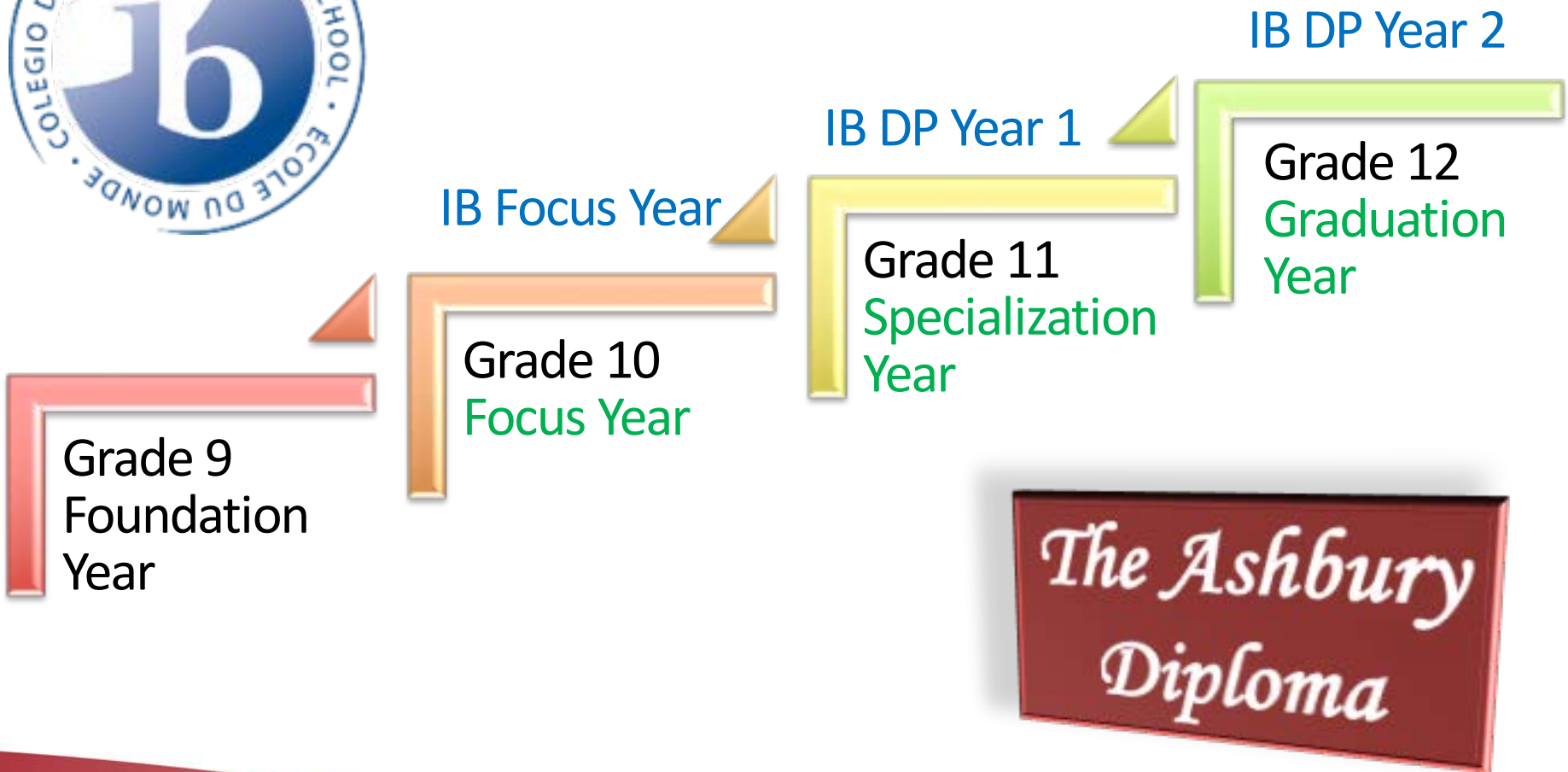

The following requirements enhance the OSSD and support our mission:

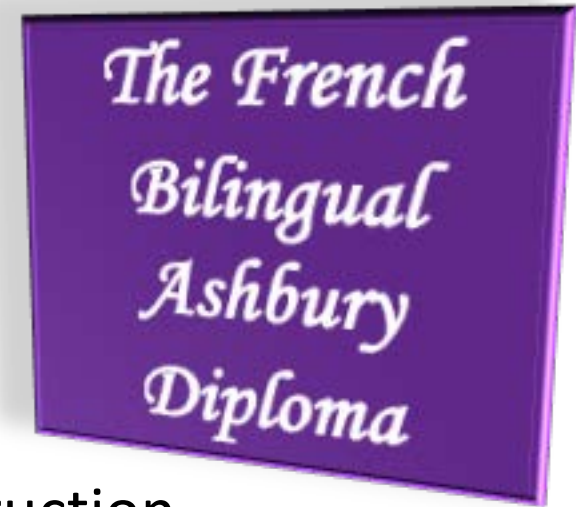


- 1 additional credit in **Art or Music or Drama**

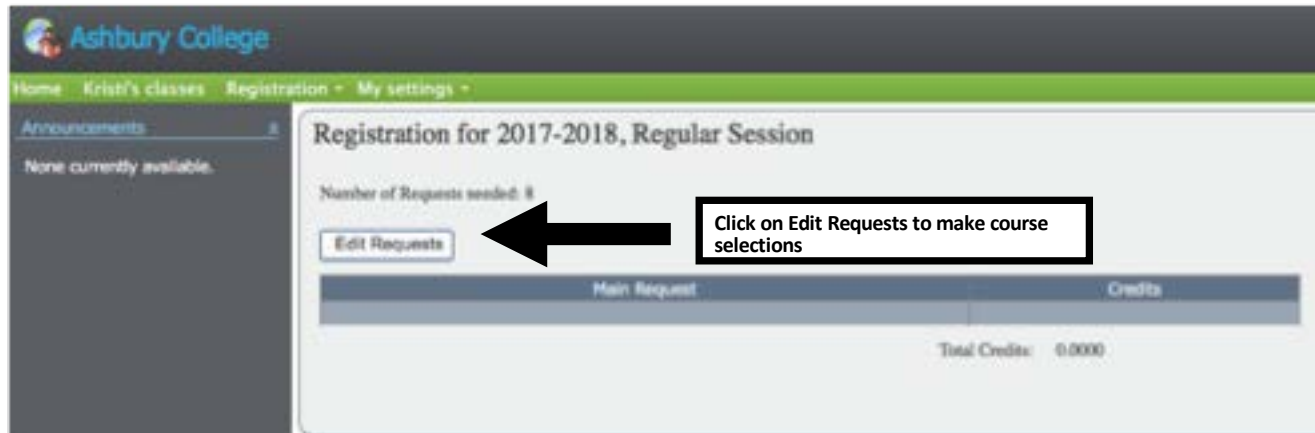
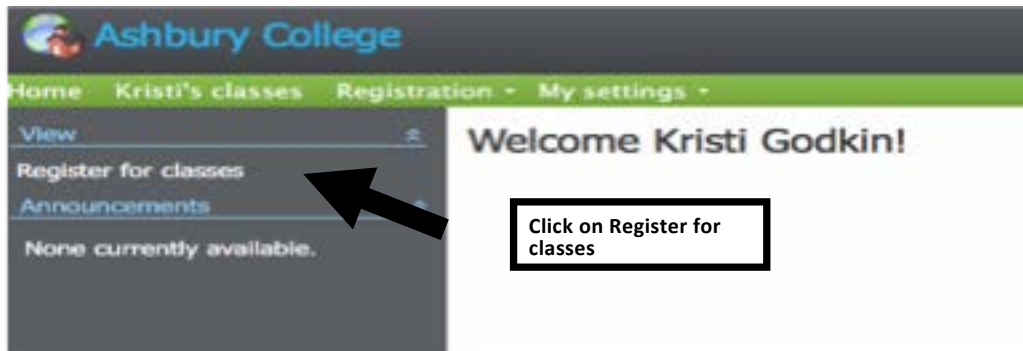
