



Grade 10 is considered the Focus Year. Students begin to choose courses based on their strengths, interests, and future plans. Most of these are compulsory credits for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma, the Ashbury Diploma and in preparation for the IB Diploma.

Students in Grade 10 take 8 credit courses. Students require 30 credits to graduate from an Ontario secondary school with an Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

Reach Ahead: Some students take summer school courses to reach ahead or to redo courses. This may alter the above progression; however, they MUST graduate with at least 30 credits that include the 18 compulsory credits required for the OSSD. We prefer that students have 31 credits by the end of Grade 12. Reach ahead credits cannot be used to reduce the expected minimum course load.

Pre IB courses: To prepare for the rigour and workload of the International Baccalaureate (IB) Program, students considering this diploma are required to choose pre-IB courses in the three areas of English, Science and History. They may also enroll in pre-IB Math (MCR3UB) if they achieve a final grade of 80% in MPM1DE or 85% in MPM1D. Students who are not eligible to enroll in MCR3UB may still pursue the IB Diploma in Grades 11 and 12. Students who are not planning to pursue the IB Diploma may still enroll in these courses for the enriched curriculum if they meet the admission requirements. *FOR NEW STUDENTS – Please see below for your Math path.

Ashbury Bilingual Diploma: Grade 10 students who are enrolled in Extended or Immersion French and are pursuing the Ashbury Bilingual Diploma may select one or more of the following elective courses to fulfill the 8 courses required for the Diploma - CHV20F/GLC20F (two half credits), CHC2DF

***New Students:** The academic records of new Grade 10 students are reviewed by the Academic Advisor during course selection. Students are typically awarded 8 credits upon entry (for Grade 9 completed outside Ontario) and must complete 22 credits over the next three years to satisfy the OSSD requirement (30 credits). Ashbury Diploma requirements are reviewed on an individual basis.

New students entering Grade 10 will be placed in Grade 10 Academic Math (MPM2D). If they wish to be placed in Pre-IB Math (MCR3UB), they must take a diagnostic test the week prior to the start of school or during the first week of school to determine suitability.

Languages: The OSSD requires one course in French. Another course in any second language is a requirement of the Ashbury Diploma. Ashbury encourages all students to continue in a second language past the minimum requirements. Some students take an ESL course in Grade 10 to further develop their English language skills. A diagnostic test will be required at the beginning of the year to determine which ESL level is most suitable.
